FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

Federal and State Programs: FAFSA is Required.

PELL Grant is assistance available only to undergraduate students and does not have to be repaid. The U.S. Department of Edu-cation uses a standard formula to determine your Expected Family Contribution (EFC). The EFC determines the value of the award.

Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (SEOG) is assistance available only to undergraduate students that does not have to be repaid. It is provided by the Federal Government to undergraduate students who have not earned a bachelor's degree and demon-strate exceptional financial need with priority to Pell recipients.

Michigan Tuition Grant is based on financial need and is available to undergraduate AB Philosophy students only. The FAFSA must be submitted by March 1st. of each year.

Federal Stafford Loans may be available to those who qualify. You must be enrolled at least half-time in a degree program.

Archdiocese of Detroit and Sacred Heart Funded Programs:

Financial Aid for Catechetical Leaders (ACE) is a program whose funds were raised in the "Stewards for Tomorrow" campaign. Assistance is available to both undergraduate and graduate students who are involved in an *approved catechetical ministry*. How to apply: access the form at www.shms.edu, under Financial Services, Financial Aid, Catechetical Leaders (ACE). Your ministry must be certified by your pastor or DRE once per academic year by the special ACE Grant certification form. Archdiocese of Detroit and Sacred Heart Funded Programs (cont.):

Parish Empowerment Fund Scholarship (PEF) AWARD IN SPRING ANNUALLY. The program provides tuition assistance to eligible lay people who work as volunteers or paid staff in a parish which meets the financial eligibility requirements for Parish Empowerment Funds Scholarships are granted for the pursuit of a preparatory course, a Certificate Diploma, or undergraduate or graduate de-gree programs. The Pastoral Ministry Grant Program through the Archdiocese of Detroit Endowment Foundation provides grants to eligible individuals to assist them in attending approved Catholic institutions for study leading to pastoral ministry certification.
